Kindergarten/New students need to have a copy of birth certificate and immunizations in the office. Any questions, please call the office at 776-2317.



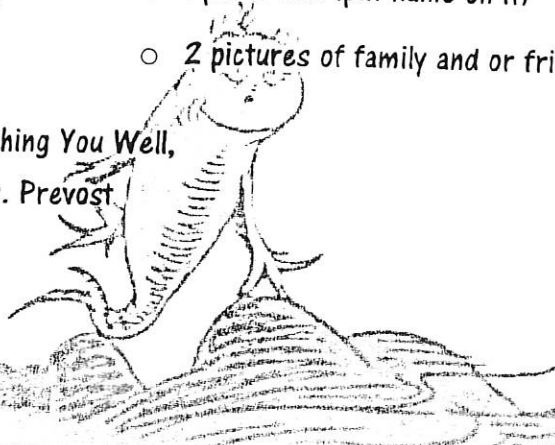
