5.1 CONSIDER THE DECLARATION OF UNFORSEEN EMERGENCY IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 20, CHAPETER 9, PART 8

This motion is based on COVID-19 risks; in recognition that the Governor's waiver of student instruction time will expire on May 7th; and in recognition that the Governor's April 22nd, 2020 Directive implicating Executive Orders 2-2020 and 3-2020 specify that elected school boards and their districts that adopt their own declaration of emergency will continue to receive all state funding, including transportation funding." Kayleen Peters seconded the motion. Shawn, Kayleen, Lance, and Charles voted yes and the motion carried.

5.2 CONSIDER ADOPTION OF REQUIRED COVID-19 EMERGENCY MEASURES, POLICY AND PROCEDURES, POLICY 1901 AFTER 1ST READING IN ACCORDANCE OF POLICY 1310

 - Federal Medical Leave Act language remains until December 31st, 2020
 - Governor mandates of the Montana phased opening regulations will be followed through the entire reopening process."
