  - Look for Teachers' Signs
    - Introduce your student and yourself to the teacher.
    - Rotate to meet the specialists and other teachers.
  - Please save your student's bookbag and school supplies to bring on AUGUST 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020!

- School Starts on August 19, 2020. (Governmental mask mandate explanation is below.)
  - On August 12, 2020, the Governor of Montana amended his July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 directive to the citizens of Montana stating any county that has four or more active COVID-19 cases that all K-12 public and private schools will wear masks.
    - Therefore, should Richland County have four or more active COVID cases <u>at any given time</u> for the duration of this declared public health state of emergency or until the Governor's

mandate is lifted masks or shields will be worn by all who attend, work, or come to the school. We will provide masks for our students and staff. All others visitors must provide their own masks.
