School Finance Information:

- In the past two years our oil and gas revenue has been decreasing due to oil and gas production.
- When the oil and gas fields were producing at their maximum, each quarter our high school district would bring in at least \$100,000 and our elementary would bring in at least \$10,000.
- Our last two quarters of 2020, we have experienced our high school district receiving between \$5,000-\$10,000 and our elementary district between \$500.00 to \$1000.00.
- Please note all schools, counties, and our state are experiencing similar decreases.
- In my years of administrative experience, there has always been a fluctuation in oil and gas revenue that occurs about every 15-20 years, pending the production cycle of oil and gas.
