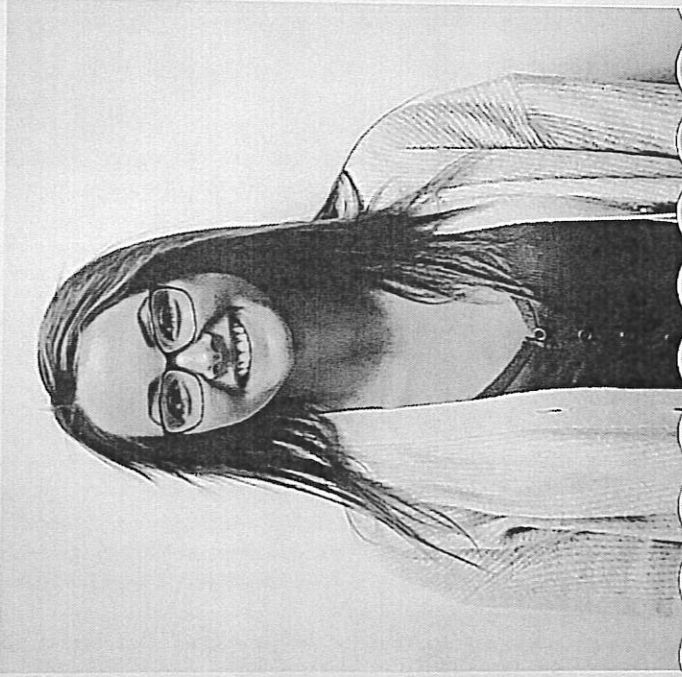
# Junior High Music Festival

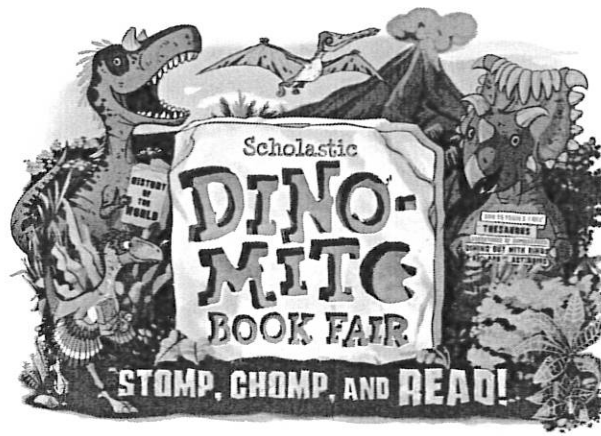

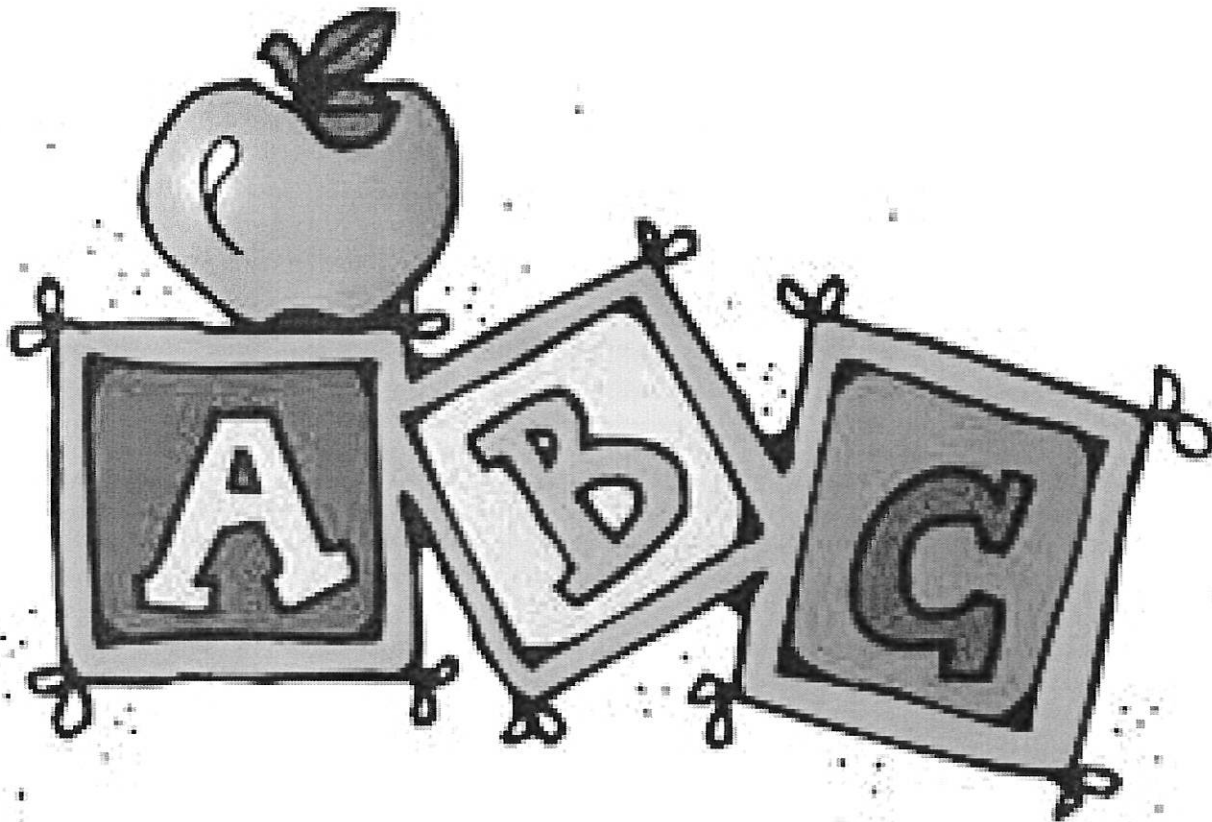

If you know of any families with children at home who do not have children in the school and therefore would not receive this notice, please have them contact the school to arrange for an appointment.

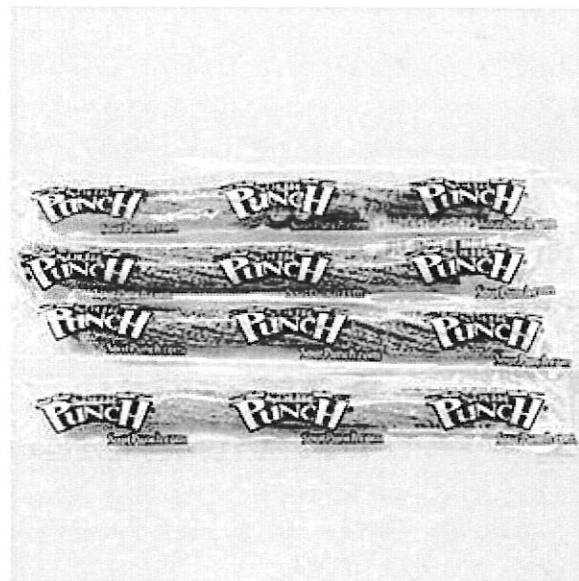

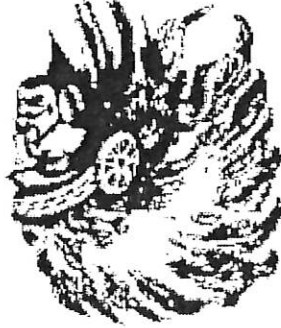
